## The Facts

In Arizona, only one Covid-19 related death in a child has been reported. This occurred May 7th 2020. The child had underlying medical conditions.

To date, there is no documented evidence of asymptomatic transmission (via The World Health Organization).

The CDC reports a remarkably low fatality rate of just 0.26%.

Our children have a higher chance of dying in a car accident on their way to school than from Covid-19.

## The Solution

The fix is simple. Provide a safe and inviting educational environment as done in the past. For those still in fear, allow them continued, virtual education.
